The children at Hayfield are proud of being a part of the school. The governors, parents and staff together believe that wearing a school uniform enhances this feeling of belonging. We also believe that school uniforms prevent the inevitable loss of self-esteem caused to individual children should a family not be able or willing to provide the newest, most expensive or most fashionable clothing and equipment.

The School Uniform at Hayfield School is:

- Navy blue cardigan or sweatshirt
- White polo shirt
- Charcoal (grey or black) skirt / trousers /shorts / dress or blue pinafore dress

Pupils are expected to attend school in a clean and tidy state and all are encouraged to wear our school uniform. The school does not stock uniforms and we recommend that parents purchase it from one of the local uniform shops or supermarket/high street store.

The wearing of a school uniform is not compulsory, particularly for those children with difficulties associated with sensory needs. Parents are encouraged to speak to a member of the school's leadership if they feel that the wearing of a uniform is having a detrimental impact on their child's attendance or emotional/mental well being.
